

97 Extract ^{from} ~~of letter from~~ W.C. Hopkinson to W.W. Cory

6 June, 1912

You have received a telegram from Mr. Reid advising you of the judgment of the Appeal Court in the Rahim matter and I learn today that the whole of the Hindu community are jubiant over the decision and steps are being taken by the leaders to try and induce some of the steamship companies in Hong Kong to bring over Hindus who have never been in Canada in spite of Order-in-Council 920 which they hold, as interpreted by Rahim's solicitors, not valid and intend contesting in every case.

It is also told me that Rahim has instructed his Solicitors to bring an action against me for unstated damages for malicious arrest on October 1st.
