of the Ministerial Association of Vancouver
arguing against the admission
of Hindus presently
residing in B.C. on grounds
that it would contribute to the
establishment of a Hindu colony as
a permanent element in Canadian life.

Pidgeon & McLaren conclude "We have
inherited the genius of the Anglo-Saxon
race — a genius that is the product
of the thought and toil of a thousand
years. If Canada is to exert the
influence on the nations of the world
that she ought to exert she must
safeguard this heritage, and
cultivate all that is best in her
life."
