Olympia Wash, Sept 21, 1907. Refers
to disorders in Bellingham several days ago
which resulted in intimidation of Hindus
& their departure from city. Note sent
from Br. Ambassador to State Dept at
Washington. Ambassador stated most of
Hindus had gone to Canada & those at
Everett in fear of outbreak.

In reply to call from Acting Secy of State
to Gov Mead of Wash & then from Gov to
Mayor Black of Bellingham. Black replied most
Hindus had left & no force had been
used. Hindus ordered out of town by
a crowd of men & boys. Mayor swore
in officers to protect them & notified
interpreter. ~~Cause~~ Had riot arrested
