Vancouver, BC. 2nd Dec. 1913.

Hernam Singh produces at Inquiry letter Nov. 3rd as follows begins: Received of Hernam Singh the sum of fifty-five gold to cover steerage passage from Vancouver/Victoria to HongKong in event of deportation by Immigration authorities for any reason whatsoever. Passenger by Empress Russia voyage 4-E. Hong Kong stamp 5/- signature P.D. Sutherland for General Traffic Agent. This is direct contravention Section 44 s.s. E. Have brought matter attention General Superintendent Peters here who immediately cabled Craddock Hong Kong, cable begins: Discontinue immediately practice collecting return fare passage money from all Hindus ends. Department's solicitors here advised stringent and immediate action on this and similar cases but think course adopted by me probably wisest one. This apparently will meet the desired ends.
