Held regularly constituted Board of Inquiry seven members present on Hernam Singh. Unanimous verdict Board he entered by misrepresentation. Released once as entered apprehended few minutes later on advice of counsel who was present at Board. MacDonald Bird represent Hernam Singh. Four local Hindus positively identified Hernam Singh as prior resident after Hernam had admitted to us he was a fraud. Counsel advised immediate arrest at close of Board of these four Hindus. Am laying charge of perjury in Courts here also probably charge Section 33 ss.8. Am writing as soon as transcript ready. Counsel states appeal will be filed. Writ adjourned till Thursday 10 am.
