THAT WHEREAS the Steamer "Komagata Maru" has been lying in the Port of Vancouver from the 23rd. day of May until the present date, with a shipload of undesirable immigrants desirous of obtaining admission into the Dominion of Canada:

AND WHEREAS it is the universal opinion of all citizens resident upon the Pacific Coast of the Dominion of Canada, that the influx of Asiatics is detrimental and hurtful to the best interests of the Dominion, from the standpoint of citizenship, public morals and labour conditions:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED:-

That this meeting strongly urges upon the Dominion Government the necessity of taking immediate action towards the removal from this Port and the Province of British Columbia of the Steamer "Komagata Maru", together with her complement of undesirable immigrants:

AND THAT stringent legislation be enacted whereby such immigration may, in the future, be entirely restricted from admission to the Dominion.
