Dear Sir:-

I return herewith the file of preliminary examination reports made by Mr. Hopkinson which you kindly let me have yesterday.

I discussed the whole matter of the test case again with Mr. Bird last night, and, as I previously instructed you, agreed to the proposal he made to test the validity of the orders in council by taking one case of a man who had a small amount of money in his possession. He therefore, agreed to go on this morning at the earliest possible moment with the Board of Enquiry for the purposes of this case. We must have this done today, as otherwise we will miss the Court of Appeal.
