Received some articles of provisions of which we are very thankful to you. We have informed already through our Captain by sending a letter to you, that we never use the flour you sent us. We again beg to say, that you may please take the trouble of changing this into W.W. (V) Mark flour, and it would be cheaper than that you have sent.

We requested to your officer to return back and change; but he refused and insisted that he could not. He said that you wrote a letter to Mr. Reid, and afterwards he would order to change.

Butter is quite insufficient for one time even. At least it takes 50 lbs for one time.

We are in short of water, and chief officer says there will be no light without water to-night.

Please send water, more butter and other articles, the list of which we have already sent you.
