Sir,

I beg to report you that my passengers who are in great trouble and whose keeping in peace will be up to the time during which, you may not interfere in my proceedings, for the following reasons:-

1. Do not make Board of Enquiry for two men only, whose landing is quite impossible on these grounds.
2. Dr. Rughnath Singh has two wives; but he dictated only one.
3. He came here in ship as a servant, and had no intention of landing.
4. Ship's servant can't land.
5. He has to pay money for which you have been informed already.
6. Mr. Bhan Singh dictated himself as a trader. He had been Government Servant for a time, and was punished by Government in any crime.
7. If he is recognised as a student, there are many of the same right, who will prove as he does.
8. If you have to do any kind of special favour with them, caring the peace of the ship, you can take them, when the ship will be ready to sail back.
