We have the honour to remind you of our yesterday's request about water, butter & etc. , but we have received no answer of that. Yesterday night there was no light for being no steam, without water. The water you sent, was only sufficient for one meal.

It is spent each day at least 8 tons for passengers and 6 tons for steam. Now there is no water.

Please take steps very soon to arrange about the above mentioned articles,

Take steps also about the dirtiness of the ship, otherwise, there will be a fear of prevailing serious sickness.

Also take away the sick men to the Hospital.
