

Sunday July 19-14 | was personally  
present & made note.

Capt came ashore about 10<sup>30</sup> 633

advised me that Gurdit Singh  
asked him to go ashore and  
get immigration agent to give him  
Gurdit money or bribe to get  
Hindus away without further trouble.  
Capt advised three or four Hindus  
injured by falling down hold  
when efforts were made to get  
up coal.

Capt. received letter from  
Com. of Hindus. See letter

Capt said that German  
Brokerage firm in Hong Kong  
and former Capt of vessel  
chartered vessel to Gurdit  
without owners consent. On arrival  
of ship at Mogi Capt was  
removed and Capt. Spaniards  
was placed in charge, altho he  
refused to three or four times.

Informed by friendly Hindus that ~~249~~  
at temple Sat night Rahim urged  
Hindus to fix Immigration Officers etc  
when a friendly Hindu got up (the  
same as he who gave information  
against Bhagwan Singh) and told  
Rahim he should not urge others  
to do things he would not risk  
his own life & liberty in doing. While  
he was talking to other Hindus jumped  
up and put a revolver in his hand  
to make it appear he had attempted  
to shoot Rahim. He was arrested  
and charged with this.

Sea horse dived up her Port  
Side to starboard side of  
Konomagata Reaver.

Damage chiefly broken  
glass & wrecked woodwork  
Some of the missiles passed  
through outer windows  
of Pilot house (all of which  
were practically smashed)  
and through pilot house  
and made heavy dents  
in wood work at back.  
Capt. was badly injured  
about head while inside  
& on duty.

All over ship damage  
of like character, large  
quantity of coal.

Sea Lion was loaded with  
30 days provisions which were  
clearly visible on decks of <sup>Tug</sup>  
Steamer. <sup>From</sup> Hindus know that  
provisions are ready waiting  
for them.
