Sir John Roberts' Lecture.

"What good has India done us? First it has increased the small island of England to the largest empire in the world, and has given them wisdom, strength and happiness. I will tell you the benefits one by one. All the regiments have been formed from India. All our merchant ships steaming in all parts of the world have been built by the wealth of India. All the big buildings in London are built out of Indian money. If it were not for India, England would be unknown today. The towns of Edinburgh, Cheltenham and Bath have all been built with Indian money. It was by the help of the Indian merchants and Indian money that we were enabled to fight Napoleon Buonaparte. It was only by the help of Indian money that we were enabled to defeat and bind him and deport him to an island in the Atlantic Ocean. These benefits have been done for England by India, but the Indian people are not aware of their strength."
