In reply to your letter of August 19th concerning Passport No. 80010, issued to Mr. Mayo Singh, which is valid only for travel to the United States of America, I wish to inform you that the procedure in validating passports for travel abroad has undergone a considerable change since the outbreak of the war, and in view of the world-wide travel restrictions it is not presumed that Mr. Mayo Singh will be proceeding to any country other than the United States at the present time.

However, should he wish to travel to any other country, it will be in order for him to submit his passport to this office, with a written application as to the countries to which he wishes to proceed.
