
Dear Sir:

I received the specimen of urine together with your letter of April 1st, 1937.

The urine was quite satisfactory from a medical view point. I would suggest that you discontinue the pills the boy is taking now and keep him on his diet. I was glad to hear that he had no more fits to date. If he continues to remain well then he will have to stay with the diet consistently for a while before we test him out by letting him eat anything he likes. Caution him about sticking with the diet entirely in the meantime, so that we may know how efficient it is in keeping fits away.
