I am in receipt of your cheque for \$20.86 which covers the taxes on your two lots in Duncan for the year 1926 but without interest.

In order to give you a clear receipt for 1926 it is necessary that you remit a further amount of .72¢. I cannot show this interest on the tax notice as it varies according to the time when the owner of the property elects to pay. In case you would like to issue another cheque I am returning the one just received, of course I can if you prefer accept it "on account".

I would also like to point out that you might prefer possibly to pay the taxes for the year 1927 while you are about it. This is quite optional but I thought you might not have grasped the fact that there is a pretty steep penalty if not paid by due date, see printed notice on top of tax demand form.
