regulations thereunder relating to such fires.

## CAMP-FIRE PERMIT.

("Forest Act Amendment Act, 1937," Chap. 23, Sec. 9.)

The provisions of the "Forest Act" and the regulations require a permittee:—

- (a.) Not to locate any fire against any log, stump, snag, or standing tree:
- (b.) To clear away all inflammable debris and material down to mineral soil for a space of three feet in every direction from the edge of every fire:
- (c.) Not to set out, start, or kindle any fire within any forest or woodland as to which notices have been posted prohibiting fires:
- (d.) To extinguish totally every fire before leaving the vicinity.
