CAMP-FIRE PERMIT.

("Forest Act Amendment Act, 1937," Chap. 23, Sec. 9.)

The provisions of the "Forest Act" and the regulations require a permittee:—

- (a.) Not to locate any fire against any log, stump, snag, or standing tree:
- (b.) To clear away all inflammable debris and material down to mineral soil for a space of three feet in every direction from the edge of every fire:
- (c.) Not to set out, start, or kindle any fire within any forest or woodland as to which notices have been posted prohibiting fires:
- (d.) To extinguish totally every fire before leaving the vicinity.

is hereby permitted to set out, start, or kindle fires for cooking or obtaining necessary warmth during the period of 1937. A Camp-Fire Permit shall be issued to any person who applies while camping, picnicking, or engaged in any similar activity within any forest or woodland subject to the observance by the permittee of all requirements of the "Forest Act" and the regulations thereunder relating to such fires.
