

POSTS TELEGRAPHS.

A. R. Receipt for Inland or Foreign Telegram.

The charges entered upon this form have been duly paid in respect of the telegram indicated by number.

The sum stated includes extra charges, if any, paid for Reply, Delivery, etc.

Should any reference become necessary, the production of this receipt will enable the telegram to be traced by the office of origin within seven days of the date of its despatch—thereafter *Complaints* respecting this telegram and applications for *Refund* involving complaints against the service should be addressed to the Director-General of Posts and Telegraphs, Traffic Branch, Calcutta, within two months in the case of an Inland and five months in the case of a Foreign telegram. Applications for refund *which do not involve complaints against the service* should be addressed to the Deputy Accountant-General, Telegraph Check Office, Calcutta.

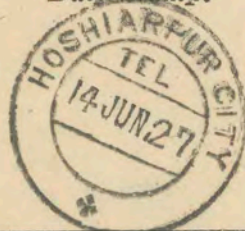
Stamps for the charges on the telegram should be affixed by the Sender to the message form to which this Receipt relates.
