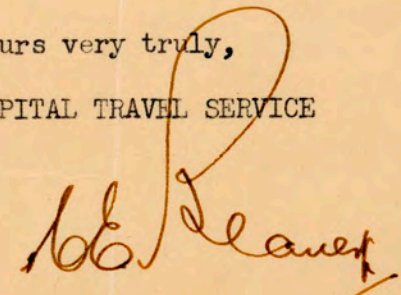
This is just a technical point now, to be cleared up between the various departments of the Canadian Immigration and Mr. Dorman advised me that he was writing you direct.
