Yesterday I phoned
to Ottawa and I was informed that
your son-in-law's case has been
favourably decided by Mr. Golliffe,
The Director of Immigration and
that the Minister, Mr. Mackinnon
has also given his Consent for
Karnail Singh to remain in Canada
permanently.

As soon as I came to know
about this case, I wrote to many
Officials in Ottawa to approach Mr.
Golliffe on behalf of Karnail Singh.

I understand that these friends of mine
in Ottawa have been doing everything
in their power to stop the deportation.
Now, I am glad to know that our
joint efforts have proved successful.
It is a good thing that you informed
me immediately after the Minister
rejected your ~~appeal~~ appeal, and
as I had one month's time to work
on this case, I was confident that
our efforts will be crowned with
success.

I believe you would have been
informed by Ottawa about the
favourable decision, before this letter
reaches you. I told Mr. Golliffe
to inform you directly about
