

FEEES FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES.

To receiving instructions for the institution of an appeal to the Minister of Mines & Resources against the decision of the Immigration Department's Board of Enquiry sitting at Victoria, B.C. rejecting the application of Karnail Singh for permission to reside in Canada permanently;

To considering the grounds of appeal, further consultations with you regarding the same, and to preparing the necessary memorandum of appeal in triplicate for submission to the Hon'ble Minister through the Immigration Inspector at Victoria;

To receiving from the Hon'ble Minister the order dismissing the appeal and transmitting it to you;

To making further representations to the Hon'ble Minister and arranging for counsel to be heard at Ottawa, and to preparing and submitting a brief to the High Commissioner for India in Canada and requesting him to make an appeal to the Hon'ble Minister to review his decision;

To further correspondence with the Hon'ble Minister and instructions to the High Commissioner for India from time to time;

To receiving from the Hon'ble Minister intimation of his decision to reverse his earlier decision in the appeal and to exercise his ministerial discretion in favour of Karnail Singh and transmitting the same to you;

To attending on the Hon'ble Minister at Ottawa regarding the issue of final orders in the matter, and to receiving the Order-in-Council permitting Karnail Singh to remain in Canada.
