Deposits should be handed to the Teller, who is the only officer authorized to receive them. Pass-books should be handed to the Ledger-keeper, who will enter all deposits and withdrawals.

Deposits made in the Savings Department are not subject to withdrawal by cheque. Special forms are provided for this purpose.

In case of the removal of a Depositor to another district, the Manager will be glad to advise regarding the transfer of the account.

REGULATIONS

1.—All deposits must be entered in the Pass-book when made, and the entries initialled by the Ledger-keeper.

2.—Interest will be allowed at such rate and on such terms as the Bank shall from time to time establish. The current rate can, at all times, be ascertained at the Bank.

3.—Interest is allowed on the minimum monthly balance and will be calculated from the date of deposit for the calendar month in which the account is

opened. No interest is allowed for the calendar month during which an account is closed.

4.—No interest is allowed on an account closed within thirty days from the date of opening.

5.—The Bank reserves the right to pay a Deposit only to the Depositor in person and to require the production of his Pass-book.

6.—When an account is closed the Pass-book must be handed in, but will be returned to the Depositor after cancellation, if desired.

7.—The Bank reserves the right to require ten days' notice when all or any portion of a deposit is withdrawn.

8.—Possession of this Pass-book does not necessarily entitle the holder to withdraw the balance of the account or any part of it at another branch.
