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II. INTRODUCTION

Manitoba's South Asian¹ community is a newer, smaller, and in many ways a unique addition to this "community of communities" called Canada. The community itself is a mosaic of people who bring with them different and rich socio-cultural traditions. As a result, small associations with limited objectives and select membership abound within the community. This fragmentation tends to reduce the effectiveness of the community participation in the affairs of society at large. An organization called the Manitoba Organization of South Asians in Canada (MOSAIC) was formed to counter this trend and to reinforce solidarity amidst diversity. It soon became apparent that there existed very little hard data upon which to base any collective strategies and choices. This prompted the Organization to seek funding for a preliminary information gathering effort that lead to the present research project.

The broad aim of the present study was to make a start toward collecting, and reporting relevant information in order to enhance the knowledge and understanding of the South Asian Community in Manitoba. Information was sought on objective socio-demographic characteristics as well as on subjective opinions about varied topics having to do in general with the adjustment of the South Asian community into the Canadian cultural milieu.

A questionnaire survey technique was employed to collect data in strict confidence. Because the study dealt with a newly located minority group, intensive efforts were made to involve all of the community organizations. This inspired confidence in the study and helped in the successful completion of the directory and the survey.

¹For the purposes of this study South Asians are considered to be people whose ethnic origin can be traced to Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Nepal, Pakistan, Sikkim and Sri Lanka as presently constituted.

Since the questionnaire technique required the selection of a statistically random sample, a complete and current directory of the 'population' under study was needed. In view of the fact that no such list existed, construction of such a directory became a priority. At the same time, the compilation of the Directory in itself, apart from its value as a basis for the study, represents a valuable contribution to the needs of the community. As such, it is included in its entirety at the end of this study as Appendix III. The Directory now lists 781 families of which 699 now live in Winnipeg and 82 families reside in the rest of Manitoba. It is strongly recommended that this Directory be updated at regular intervals.

The Snowball Sampling Technique used in the construction of the Directory is elaborated in Chapter III and the underlying rationale for the choice of the technique is presented in Appendix I. The Questionnaire used in the study is included as Appendix II. Because of the disappointingly low rate of response, only the description of the various frequency distributions are presented in Chapter IV.

The study took much longer to complete than was originally envisaged, primarily because of the rather long and time consuming process involved in the construction of the Directory using the Snowball technique, as well as the intricacies involved in the administration of the questionnaire. The efforts were no doubt worthwhile, since a better estimate of the South Asian population is now available. It must be realized that this study represents a beginning at gaining some understanding of the size and general characteristics of the community in Manitoba.

Both time and finances precluded at this stage from pursuing this study to any greater detail.

III. STUDY DESIGN

DIRECTORY CONSTRUCTION THROUGH SNOWBALL SAMPLING

1. Introduction

The purpose of this chapter is to detail the study design with respect to constructing the directory. Compiling a directory, especially for a population group which is small relative to the entire population, creates special technical problems and novel procedures are necessary. The portrayal of various characteristics of South Asian households is more straightforward and will be discussed in a following section.

2. The 1971 Census Enumeration of South Asians

The 1976 Census did not ask sampled households questions ascertaining ethnicity. Hence, the most recent information available from Statistics Canada is contained in the 1971 Census and we can expect the situation to be markedly different today.

The following table gives the distribution of South Asians in Manitoba based upon the 1971 Census Population by Sex and Ethnic Group.

The total population of Manitoba is about 988,000 as per the 1971 Census.

3. Purpose of Directory

The purpose of the study, among other things, was the creation of, as complete as possible, a directory of South Asians in Manitoba with a listing

of current addresses and telephone numbers. In addition, some estimate of the coverage of the directory and, therefore, the size of the population was required. That is, it is necessary to know how complete was such a listing.

Given the extremely low proportion of South Asians in the general population (see above), as well as the small size of the budget available, a "pure random" sample, whether stratified or not, was impossible. An ordinary survey would have been prohibitive in cost, provide poor estimates of population sizes, and prove of little use for constructing a current directory. Since various partial list of South Asians were available which were known to "cover most South Asians", it was decided to employ a "snowball" sampling technique. The basic premise of such a design is to begin with some partial list of households known to be of South Asian origins and then proceed to enquire of persons on this list to confirm their status. Each person on this list is asked to name other South Asians and the process is continued, thereby building up the list. In such manner, the directory is compiled. In addition, an estimate of the coverage is possible. Heuristically, the process may be explained as follows. If the original list contained all the population of South Asians, then every person named will be on the original listing. On the other hand, if the original list contained almost none of the South Asian population, say only one person, then every person named will not be on the original list. By examining the incidence of persons named on the original list, an estimate of the completeness of the list can be constructed (see Appendix I).

The advantages of the Snowball Sampling technique are:

- i) The technique updates addresses and telephone numbers listed in the previous list. Because families will have moved and the previous listing is old, this is essential to compile a current directory.
- ii) The technique omits from the directory families confirmed not to be of South Asian origin as well as households which have, since the creation of the last listing, moved outside of Manitoba. Indeed, the survey discovered that 23% of originally listed households had moved out of Manitoba and another 8% were not of South Asian origin.

- iii) The technique extends the coverage of previous listings since households are asked to name individuals they know, many of whom will not be on the original list. In this survey, it was found that 402 households on the original listing provided 185 new households which were not on the original list. This represents a 46% increase in the number of names for the directory.
- iv) Subject to certain assumptions, an estimate of the approximate coverage of the directory can be obtained. It is estimated that the number of South Asian households in Manitoba is between 850 and 975 for a directory coverage of between 80% and 92%.
- v) The technique is very efficient in creating a directory. However, the information can also be used to make statistical inferences about various relationships present in the population (see L.A. Goodman, "Snowball Sampling", Annals of Mathematical Statistics, 1961, pp. 148-179). In the present sampling, it was found that when a household was asked to name another person, only about 4% of the households will name each other.

4. The Initial List Sampling Frame

The initial list sampling frame consisted of a master list (compiled several years previously), merged with five other partial lists of varying degrees of quality and dates. Each household on the merged list was verified in the latest telephone directory; in the same process, households having identical surnames as those verified as of South Asian origin but not on the sampling frame, were added. The final frame resulted in 1,031 names with corresponding telephone numbers. Each of these 1,031 households were attempted with a telephone interview, the main purpose of which was to confirm the origin, address and the phone number, etc., and to solicit the names of up to six individuals of South Asian origin known to the household. Respondents were asked, if possible, to supply three names in Winnipeg, and three names outside of Winnipeg. The status of this first stage interview is as follows:

- d) Source of Names - The final sampling frame was constructed by merging lists obtained from various sources; namely, the Hindu Society, the Tibet Society, the India Association, the MOSAIC Organization, and a previous listing compiled by Mr. Suprovar Sarkar and from the Manitoba telephone directory.

IV. SOCIO-METRIC ANALYSIS

A questionnaire survey of the South Asian community in Manitoba was conducted in the Summer/Fall of 1979. The questionnaire was divided into three parts. The first part was designed to gather objective, factual information with a view towards developing a socio-demographic profile of the community. The second and third parts were designed to elicit information about their activities and opinions. The purpose was to learn more about the concerns of individuals. It was also hoped to see if these individual opinions, on coalition and juxtaposition, might yield identifiable patterns of thinking or acting at the group and community level.

One hundred and fifty households were randomly selected out of a meticulously constructed directory of South Asians and the questionnaire was administered by trained and skilled interviewers. Of these 150 households contacted, 57 completed questionnaires were realized. Thirty-two households refused to be included in the study and 61 were unavailable for various reasons.

Because of the low rate of responses, it was decided to present the data with a description of the various frequency distributions of responses.

Following are the data tabulated in a summary form.

V. CONCLUSION

The general objectives of the study were achieved. The directory which represents the major component of this research project, has a current listing of approximately 90% of households in Manitoba of South Asian origins. This represents the first such attempt at developing a comprehensive listing with respective addresses and telephone numbers. Of the 781 families, which is about 3,000 people, listed in the directory, only about 10.5% (82 families) live outside the City of Winnipeg; mostly in communities such as Thompson, Brandon and Flin Flon. Those living within the City of Winnipeg (699 families) are distributed throughout the city, with no identifiable concentration pattern. The list will have to be updated at regular intervals and it is strongly recommended that this task be undertaken by the organization.

The survey attempt at constructing a preliminary socio-demographical profile of the community has also, to an extent, been realized. The socio-demographic profile of the community is that of younger families (77% of ages 45 or under) consisting on an average of four members per household. The majority of the families are recent arrivals mostly after 1970 (84% immigrated to Canada after 1970). The educational background indicates that over 60% received at least a first university degree level education and about 40% of these also received post-graduate training at the level of M.A. or Ph.D. degrees, this correlates very strongly with both their occupations and incomes. Hindi and Punjabi are the most commonly spoken languages at home, but a very high percentage (97%) of the household heads also speak English fluently. Hinduism is the most common religious affiliation of both household heads and spouses, followed by Christianity. Sikhism and Islam religions are equally distributed.

A general understanding of some of the behavioural and attitudinal aspects of the community within the larger Canadian milieu can now be gained. This information was gathered through a special section in the questionnaire survey using both direct and correlate questions. But due to the small

sample size and the poor rate of the questionnaire survey responses, it was felt that the data should be presented in tabular form to maintain objectivity and to avoid imputing any wrong interpretation. The data is self-explanatory and any attempt at its detail description and analysis could easily be misconstrued. Suffice to say that the information presents a very interesting profile of South Asians and should prove very useful to the community.

It is hoped that further analysis of the data, as well as further studies, will be forthcoming from those interested in the ethnic and multicultural aspects of Canadian society. This study represents only a beginning at gaining some understanding of the South Asian community in Manitoba.

VI APPENDICES

APPENDIX I

ESTIMATING THE POPULATION SIZE

Estimates of the population size of South Asians under two alternative assumptions are noted below:

A) Random Choice Assumption

assuming that each person names another person randomly, the expected proportion of the population that is interviewed when a one-stage, one-name snowball sample is drawn is

$$1 - (1-p) \exp(-p) \quad \text{as } N \text{ approaches infinity}$$

This assumes that the first stage sample is random with sampling proportion p . In this study, the 402 households in the first stage (who gave at least one name) gave 204 additional names for the second stage. An estimate of the proportion of households interviewed after the first stage is therefore $p = \frac{(402 + 204)}{402}$. Solving the above equation for p yields:

$$p = \frac{(402 + 204)}{402} = 1 - (1-p) \exp(-p)$$

which yields an estimate of $p = .388$

The estimate of population size is $402 / .388 = 1036$. However, since naming of households is not strictly random, the figure 1036 can be regarded as an upper limit to the population size.

B) Mutual Contact Approximation Assumption

The following notations were adopted:

M_{11} : Number of pairs of individuals in the population who name each other. This is termed a mutual relation.

r_1 : Number of individuals in the sample who enter mutual relationships with individuals who do not appear in the sample, but are in the first stage. Note that expected value of

$$r = 2M_{11} p(1-p)$$

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B) Mutual Contact Approximation Assumption

The following notations were adopted:

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y_1 : Number of individuals in the sample who enter mutual relationships with individuals who do not appear in the sample, but are in the first stage. Note that expected value of

$$y = 2M_{11} p(1-p)$$

y_2 : Number of individuals in the sample who enter mutual relationships with other individuals in the sample, note that expected value of

$$\frac{Y^2}{2} = M_{11}p^2$$

y : ($= y_1 + y_2$)

Number of individuals in the sample who enter mutual relationships with individuals who are either in the sample or in the first stage. Note that expected value of $y = 2M_{11}p$ and that an unbiased estimate of $M_{11} = y/2p$

C) Estimate of the Population Size

Assuming the first stage was a random sample of 402 with sampling proportion p , the estimate of the number of "Mutual relationships" in the population is

$$M_{11} = y/2p = \frac{24 + 23.8}{2p} = \frac{23.9}{p}$$

with variance (M_{11}) as

$$\frac{M_{11}(1-p)}{2p} = \frac{23.9(1-p)}{p \cdot 2p} = \frac{11.95(1-p)}{p^2}$$

A 95% confidence interval for M_{11} =

$$\frac{23.9}{p} \pm \frac{1.96}{p} \frac{3.46(1-p)^{\frac{1}{2}}}{p}$$

or

$$\frac{23.9}{p} \pm \frac{6.78}{p} \frac{(1-p)^{\frac{1}{2}}}{p}$$

Since another estimate of $y_2/2$ is $M_{11} p^2$ two equations can be used to solve for p using the 95% confidence limits of M_{11} .

Thus for the lower limit, the solution for p is:

$$\frac{(23.9)}{p} + \frac{6.78}{p} \cdot \sqrt{(1-p)} p^2 = 12$$

which yields an estimate of p of 41.25%.

For the upper limit, the solution for p is:

$$\frac{(23.9)}{p} - \frac{6.78}{p} \cdot \sqrt{(1-p)} p^2 = 12,$$

which yields an estimate of p of 61.00%

Therefore, the estimate of lower bound for the population size is $402/.6100 = 659$ and the estimate of upper bound for the

population size is $402/.4125 = 974$. However, since 781 households are recorded in the directory the range is therefore 781 to 974 households.
