Dear Editor:

This letter is to acquaint you with the work of the Multicultural History Society of Ontario and to solicit your cooperation in our current Ontario ethnic newspaper project.

The Society, an archival and research institute, was formed in the autumn of 1976 by a group of academics, civil servants, archivists and librarians who saw a need for a special effort to record the province's immigrant and ethnic past. The following objectives are listed in the Society's papers of incorporation: 1. to promote and advance studies into the history of all ethnocultural groups within the Province of Ontario; 2. to collect and prepare guides to material relevant to the history of these groups; 3. to arrange for the safekeeping and accessibility of all archival materials which are collected; 4. to encourage the publication of primary research on ethnocultural groups in the province; 5. to publicize the important contribution by all communities to the growth and development of Ontario.

> Ontario Ethnic Newspapers: Bibliography and Microfilming Project is one of our major endeavours to achieve our goal to preserve the province's rich multi-ethnic heritage. We understand that your newspaper Ui Szo / New Word has been a major forum for the development of the Hungarian Canadian community and its distinct culture. We believe it is essential that a complete set of Ui Szo be preserved either in original copies or microform in a public institution like ours and made available for future historians.

Our initial work in this newspaper project involves the compilation of a detailed inventory sheet on each ethnic newspaper in Ontario. We would like to talk with you about including your newspaper in this project. I will be in touch with you shortly.
