3. first employment-five at sawmill (Port Moody)

note that the King was crowned in Delhi.

7. important wrt Komagata Maru; soem 20 Canadian residents were stranded in Hong K  
because of the steamship line's refusal to sell tickets. this was origin focal  
point for KM events.

9. one of the powerful arguments.
