1. ed "The Aryan" Magazine. resident in Victoria p 86 "official leader" of 4000 Sikhs.

87. stresses Br. Commitment.

→ affirms Queens' Jubilee 1897 then to Canada + "the praries which were just like the plains of the Punjab".

Original intent = to settle as farmers. "Most of them in BC + Alberta have bought land.

Others: 1. land clear & dairy, market gardens.

DAVIDSON + MACRAE — N. West. employs 350.

88. Claims all other groups accorded better treatment.

→ Stresses 'right to travel or dwell' rel Br. Govt.

89. Claims the "continuous journey law was (1908) aimed at Japanese coming from Honolulu.

89. Notes poss. Bad effects rel publicity in Europe India.
