would change the fundamental composition of the Canadian population. Any
considerable oriental immigration would, moreover, be certain to give rise to
social and economic problems of a character that might lead to serious
difficulties in the field of international relations. The government, therefore,
has no thought of making any change in immigration regulations which would
have consequences of this kind."
