1. There was a Depression (mild) in 1906 p123
2. p125 The Chinese performed a work stoppage as a result of the riot. Riot Sunday Sept 7 until Wednesday.

125 - Wednesday 798 E I's arrive - no one would take them in p126 - They had \$ but no one would rent to them "E I's subsisted through the winter on the charity of citizens of their compatriots...."

1908 → 11 Boom years

p134: 1912 World Depression affected BC + all 14 H.

p136: City of Vancouver spending \$150,000 during the winter for unemployment relief.

"The one thing ~~that~~ Vancouver escaped was large scale labor trouble"

p152: During the '20's - a permanent system of unemployment.

1920: 10,000 white, 3500 Chinese unemployed

p161 → press history.

p179 - 1933 - 34,000 on relief
