It is much to be regretted that Ganda Sing may unwittingly have not made full application as required by the regulations, stop. We feel that Ganda Sing Citizen of our Great Empire will if admitted to Canada be an asset to our Dominion, he and his brother Mayo Sing referred to in our petition can not be classed with the average East Indian coming to this country. They are of high Caste well educated and read, write and speak our language well. Trusting you will again take this matter under consideration.
