General Information Bulletin (forwarded on request addressed to The Registrar, Stanford University, California), free of charge) for full information concerning admission requirements, basis of selection of applicants, numerical limitations, special regulations for women, college aptitude test, tuition, fees, living expenses, and other details.

ADMISSION TO THE UPPER DIVISION

Candidates for admission to the Upper Division must have satisfactorily completed at least 87 quarter units (two years) of collegiate work at an institution of recognized standing. Graduates of California junior colleges, or other approved junior colleges, may be considered eligible for this group. (Satisfactory completion of work means that the average grade of the entire record, and of the last quarter for seniors) is at least equivalent to an average grade of C at Stanford. (See Information Bulletin for interpretation.)

Applications for admission must be made on this blank, and the candidate must indicate the school in which he desires to select his major subject. All credentials must be filed with The Registrar on or before the dates named below.

The credentials required are: (1) Personal application for admission with Upper Division standing; (2) complete transcripts of college work completed, including statement of honorable dismissal from the institution last attended, or list of courses in progress; (3) two statements of personal qualifications, on blanks furnished by the University, at least one of which must be sent in by a teacher in the institution last attended; (4) record of any college aptitude or similar test other than that given by Stanford University.

All applications, and all required credentials, must be on file with The Registrar, Stanford University, on the dates indicated below if they are to receive consideration. (Earlier for School of Medicine.)

Men Sept. 15 for the Autumn Quarter; Dec. 15 for the Winter Quarter;
March 15 for the Spring Quarter; June 15 for the Summer Quarter.

Women May 1 for the Autumn Quarter; Dec. 1 for the Winter Quarter;
March 1 for the Spring Quarter; June 1 for the Summer Quarter.

After these dates admission may still be granted if the quotas have not been filled.

APPLICATION FEE

An Application Fee of Five Dollars is payable at the time of filing an application for admission to the University, and is not refundable.
