

[Neil Gilchrist] Diary - 1914: [entry for July 21, 1914]

we began talking about seeing a ship
out of the shipyard in the harbor
complete at last
JULY TUESDAY 21 1914

Fairly fine.

Ros, Rus & I went down to the
wharf at 8 and waited till
12 expecting to see the ship make
sails and meet out of the harbor
on the Komagata Maru at the
"Rainbow" anchored about a block
off from it & nothing happened.
We enjoyed ourselves listening
to a drunk conversation on the
situation & throwing out withers
about the Highlanders. Then we
had fun watching a little drunk
cockney of 8 stone & 4 four offering
"to ride a goat with anyone of
me own weight." Ros, Rus, George
& I played cards till 4:30.

at band concert & met Kate &
