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To Immigration Agent from Committee "K.M."

Dear Sir,

We beg to inform you that you will have 15 men 5 tons
a day, 15 tons but when the officers on board measure it,
they find it is 12 tons only. We don't know where does
the 3 tons go away. You try to find out from
board. It is not an easy job to find out. The quality
of food you find every day is not sufficient for the
men.

It is required to have for the men & for all the day
15 tons of food.

It is also required to have 15 tons of light. There is no
light at all for the men for 1 day, which is very
difficult for the men on board, without light.

As you know you have 15 tons of food, 15 tons of
meat, but about this is a very great work.
Every day 15 tons of food is required for the men.
Food which is very essential for the men, without it we
can't make ready & safe it.

The food you find is not good to eat, poor in feeding
and to eat the food of flour.

There is need of a doctor to inspect the men every
day, because in 15 tons of food there is 15 tons of
meat, as you know the food there is poor.

It is only your duty to provide the men with food
and if necessary, because you have 15 tons of food
available.

We request you that you please send 15 tons
of food, but the remaining 15 tons, have not been
sent to you to be, as you know, in each of 15 tons,
you should not wait to eat.
