TELEGRAM

Ottawa, 11 January, 1913

Canadian Government desires that you will obtain the consent of the
United States Government for the authorizing of the special agent of the
United States Department of Justice at San Francisco to cooperate with
Mr. W.C. Hopkinson, an officer of the Interior Department, who has been
stationed at Vancouver reporting on Hindu situation and now engaged in
special work in this relation in San Francisco. Department of Interior
states that Hopkinson is most desirous of securing reliable information
with regard to one named Joe Dial now Berkeley California, who is
supposed to have arrived at New York within past 10 months.
