TELEGRAM

New Westminster, 5 January 1915

I today through official interpreter Mrs. Dalton
made a very thorough examination upon
mental condition of Mewa Singh and I
find him to be well oriented, shows
good retention and thus is absolutely
no evidence of delusions or hallucinations
and although a devoted follower
of his own creed shows no evidence
of religious mania. He fully
appreciates the character of his
offense and also the penalty that
it is necessary for him to pay. I
therefore feel satisfied that the
man is to all intents and purposes
Sane.
