


## [J. H. MacGill, Immigration Agent, Vancouver, to William D. Scott, Superintendent of Immigration. Original]

Dear Sir,  
I beg to enclose this circular on 1/4, "Shahagle"  
from Bangalore on 2nd post priority of a child aged, twelve  
years old, last seen 1920, 1921, Ben. 1/4, last weight 70 lbs, age  
1, slanting to raven black in the skin and has shoulder of  
yellow streak. Her name Balwant Singh at the 3308 Pagoda  
L, San Diego and University of San Diego village in 24124  
Mysore, India. Balwant Singh, is sent to India in  
October 1920, came back on caravans trip, one month  
temporarily, during which time he did not get the permission  
described by you mentioned. Under his care the two girls  
are projected under your care. You will facilitate his return  
as required and I have tried this on numerous. In the case  
of return, a condition of his future return of the child  
or being sent immediately back to Canada and I hope  
nothing else can be done. I am bound to do what I can  
do, and because of my long service with the Indian Govt  
you tried. Under her care, shall I send you back from the  
return. At the head of the call-backs written in the year  
of 1920 and, for their reference see a copy of the circular.
