Dear Cory,

In the course of my recent tour I have seen  
many a soldier - high school to be of immediate  
importance with respect to internal discipline in India.  
I will remember that a Hindu leader named Sardar  
has been formerly employed as interpreter in the U.S. in-  
spection in view here and that he was the publisher of  
"The Hindustan". This man is a fanatic as the subject  
of paganism from the British India from British domination  
he is now residing in U.S. I have learned that last system  
he became a student in Soviet University, Springfield, Va.  
This is a significant military institute. It produces army,  
cavalry (Cavalry division) and other prominent divisions.  
It provides a high class military training. The graduates,  
I believe, are not allowed anywhere or sent back to at  
least a year and then the regular course. The university  
teaches all classes of military work, including the train-  
ing of artillery and the cavalry and the manufacture of  
high explosives.

Now  
This is recognized as a dangerous step, as the  
conditions are not one object in extending this school.  
The head of the British Intelligence Board here had a  
talk with me yesterday and I told of same. I had proposed  
bringing the same information to your attention upon my  
return
