PARAPHRASE OF TELEGRAM

21 August 1914

H.R. H. the Duke of Connaught at
San Francisco will probably find
you name of a large number of
British Indians who have sailed
from that port amongst whom there
may be some of seditious or
dangerous character who may be
known to Mr. Hopkinson. Foreign
Office have authorized direct
communication to you from San Francisco
instead of through me in order to
save time and expense. Could
Indian Department make necessary
arrangements for informing Indian
Office and Government of India
of names of individuals suspected.
