TELEGRAM

London 26 October 1914

Secret America. Please see my secret telegram
of the 24th of September. Hopkinson was
murdered on the 21st of October by an
Indian at Court House, Victoria. No
further details are known yet. Please
refer to Duke of Cornwall's Secret
dispatch dated 20th May sent to Director,
Criminal Intelligence Department. Murder
is the outcome of work done for India
I am enquiring, with a view to a
financial grant, as to the circumstances
of the widow and family. Our grant must
come from Secret Funds, unless the
fact of the murder results in the publication
of Hopkinson's relations with us.
