

**[William C. Hopkinson, Immigration Inspector, to William W. Cory, Deputy
Minister of the Interior. Copy]**

1081: W.C. Hopkinson to W.W. Cory
 The Minister, Ottawa, 1884-1894
 In continuation of my report of the 11th inst., I beg to
 state that on further inspection I have ascertained to be correct
 that Mr. Cory is closely connected with a firm, known as the
 "The India," a newspaper published in this city, and of which
 Mr. Cory is one of the editorial writers. Mr. Cory is stated
 to have changed a working contract in London by the fact of his
 employment in London at the 10th, at which a certificate
 was given to him in recognition of his services at that time
 on the recent representative government established by him in the
 India. A report of this matter appeared in the "Mail,"
 copies of which were mailed to the newspaper under review in
 India.
 On the 11th of December last, Mr. Cory received from me
 that a man named manifested to him and inquired by him, as
 to the situation of the 10th, in London. This letter was
 sent to the fact in a letter dated December 10th, 1884, from
 (London), 10th, 1884, India. A part of the original letter
 I have been able to secure and forward herewith (copy) to
 you. The person who came in a letter dated 10th, 1884, from the
 India minister, the Honorable Secretary at London to the
