CONVERSATION BETWEEN H. H. STEVENS, M. P., AND DR. RUGHUNATH SINGH, HELD AT THE OFFICE OF THE CANADIAN IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT, VANCOUVER, WITH INSPECTOR HOPKINSON ALSO PRESENT AT THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE CONVERSATION.

MR. HOPKINSON (to Dr. Singh): Dr. Stevens is the Member of Parliament for the City of Vancouver, and as the representative of the Government - in that capacity - he wants to know from you whether you may be willing and able to inform him as to the treatment of the present case.

DR. SINGH (to Mr. Stevens): It might be that you get some technical questions that I may not understand.

MR. STEVENS: I want to know what else you think something we have the records. Mr. Hopkinson the Government is often are very anxious for me to know something about it.

DR. SINGH: Well we say sometimes you like ask I will answer as well as I can.

MR. STEVENS: I want to be able to advise Mr. Hopkinson that you understand just what conditions are now. They are telling me that you were a little bit afraid of your personal safety?

DR. SINGH: No, I am afraid of my safety.

MR. STEVENS: Some of them threaten you and these are things?

DR. SINGH: No, I don't think myself threatened by. He threatened me that they were going to kill me if I do not go to some extent and go over the gateway - because they suspected that I was allowed to come without any more money of money - they think that I have given something against them - the condition of the city.
