Sir:-

We the members of the Committee of the passengers hereby advise you that you made an arrangement for the police, when you went ashore yesterday. Instead of policemen you asked our steamer last night at 1.30 A.M. Many of our passengers have received serious injuries.

We have committed no offence so that you may send the police to attack us.

Yesterday we addressed a letter to the British Consul through you, but sorry you did not bring the message, so that we made all our passengers.

We all are hungry since three days and you taking part of this money that we take away the steamer, to kill us in the way with hunger.

Last night when the police attacked the steamer you did not come out of your cabin, though you were informed, which proves your carelessness about passengers and your intention of killing us, but we were fortunate enough to save our lives, though the police fired their guns at us.

Captain has no right to take away the steamer without previous permission.

There are some provisions which you and Immigration Agents say that they would supply the provisions etc. after 10 miles.
