Dear Sir:-

I return herewith the file of preliminary investigation reports made by Mr. Layton which you kindly let me have yesterday.

I discussed the whole matter of the boat case again with Mr. Reid last night, and, as I previously instructed you, agreed to the proposal he made to test the validity of the evidence in regard to the boat case of a man who had a small amount of money in his possession. He therefore, agreed to go on this evening at the earliest possible moment with the boat of landing for the purpose of this case. The names of the men to whom I have referred are:- Mount High (one of these High) and Mount High (one of Valde High).

Kindly have these two men brought on board at once, allow Mr. Reid to interview them and to make his statement as to what was he will go on with all arrange for the sitting of the Court at the earliest possible moment this evening at 11.30 o'clock, so that no necessary delay will be caused. We must have this done today, or otherwise we will miss the Court of appeal.
