

Copy of letter from Rughunath Singh to Reid re sickness on board, and re his own family's landing

Myo, The Dignitary Agent,
Toronto, N. Y.

Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that the men on the ship are getting rapidly ill, owing to their longer periods and the medicine and medical comforts have run short.

I myself with my family cannot get anything to eat because there are no provisions on board and nobody is willing to cook for us now.

Under the above circumstances I am quite unable to look after the patients. Will you be so kind as to make the necessary arrangements for the medical treatment of the passengers of the S.S. Rongpala here?

I deem it necessary to ask you also to request that you I with my family be allowed to board ship with others.

I could never live in point out as well that I am a detachment servant holding a respectable post in His Majesty's Indian Army and as I must see my own family the same time in my own as in the case of Dignitary. Please excuse trouble and favour me with a reply at your earliest convenience.
