For many months I have been spied upon
by British secret service operatives,
but have gone about my affairs openly
and have not turned my statements
or modulated my declarations because
of their presence. My arrest was not
a real surprise; I had been expecting
it for a long time.

My arrest calls public attention
to the despicable pro-British subservience
of the United States government which is
to meet a balance of Blundell Leveson
foreign policy. The Democratic administration
in taking the part of England as anyone
can see who disavows the entire administration's
attitude towards Great
Britain on the canal tolls question.
