Hindus to be deported
The 518 Hindus who arrived on the CPR
steamer Taita on Wednesday were examined by
Mr. Morris yesterday morning and 179
will have to return to India, some
because they do not have the necessary
cash & others because they were suffering
from trachoma or were physically defective.
The immigration regulations do not state
specifically the amount of cash
an immigrant must have but give
discretionary power to immigration officers
by declaring that no person who is
likely to become a public charge shall
be allowed to land. Morris estimates
that a Hindu will less than \$25
stand a poor chance of finding work
before his money runs out. So two
who could not show \$25 were
admitted.
