Hernam Singh produces at Inquiry Letter No. 101 as follows begins: Received of Hernam Singh the sum of fifty-five gold to cover stevedore passage from Vancouver, Victoria to HongKong in want of inspection by Immigration authorities for any reason whatsoever. Passenger by Express Bussele voyage 4-1. Hong Kong stamp by signature P. D. Sutherland for General Traffic Agent. This is direct contravention Section 41 a. a. a. Have brought matter attention General Superintendent Peters here who immediately called Graham Hong Kong, while begins: Discontinue immediately practice collecting return fare passage money from all Chinese emigrants. Department's collectors have advised stringent and immediate action on this and similar cases but think course adopted by me probably wisest one. This apparently will meet the desired ends.
