Held regularly constituted Board of Inquiry seven members present
on Gurnea Singh. Unanimous verdict Board he entered by misrepresentation
released same as entered apprehended few minutes later on advice of
counsel who was present at Board. MacDonald Bird represent Herman
Singh. Four local Hindus positively identified Herman Singh as prior
resident after Gurnea had admitted to us he was a fraud. "Gurnea"
advised immediate arrest of those at Board of those four Hindus. An
inquiry charge of perjury in Courts here also probably charge Justice
B.S. 22.0. As writing as soon as transcript ready. Journal status appeal
will be filed. Trial adjourned till Thursday 10 am.
