 Japanese City to which port rights were  
 granted.

The principal towns in 1858 - Tokyo  
 with a pop of 1,000,000. Osaka  
 Kyoto Nagasaki Yokohama  
 and Hakodate. Yokohama soon became  
 regarded as the European headquarters  
 and it was a largely European town.

At the present time there are some  
 4,500 miles of railway open (1903)
